A Message From THE QUARTERMASTER

The new membership year is in full swing. As of this writing, we are currently at only 84% membership for 2008. As always, our goal is to achieve 100% +1 new member no later than December 31, 2007. To ensure that you retain your Post privileges after January 1, 2008, please pay your membership dues now. Dues may be paid by mailing payment directly to VFW National Headquarters, online at <http://emem.vfw.org> or by dropping them off at the Post to my attention.

Continuous (annual) members... If you have not considered it in the past, I would urge you to think about converting your membership to become a Life Member. The VFW now offers an installment payment plan to make becoming a Life Member even easier. You may elect either an 11 month or

23 month payment schedule, after an initial payment of \$35. Members are then invoiced each month until all payments have been made. Invoices also include a "pay-off amount" should you choose to pay your membership off early. Members choosing the installment option will be issued a "Provisional Life Member" card upon initial payment and will receive their permanent Life Member card once the final payment has been made.
